

Gold Ribbed Hare's Ear



Recipe

Hook:	Mustad 9672 or 3xl nymph hook
Thread:	Tan 6/0
Tail:	hare ear or brown hackle
Body:	blended hares ear dubbing
Rib:	gold tinsel/wire
Wing case:	turkey quill

Tying Instructions:

Start your thread behind the eye of the hook. Wrap back to the bend of the hook. Tie in a small bunch of hares ear fur from the side of the mask. Then wrap the thread to the mid-point of the shank. Tie in the gold tinsel/wire. Bind it down to the shank as you wrap towards the bend. Dub some blended hares ear onto the thread and dub the body (abdomen) to a point slightly ahead of the mid-point of the shank. Tie in a section of turkey quill approximately ¼" in width laying back over the dubbed body. Dub the thorax of the fly over the butts of the turkey quill, making the thorax slightly fuller than the body. Wrap the tinsel in spaced out wraps toward the eye. You may have to move the turkey a little to wrap the tinsel to the eye. Tie off the tinsel. Fold the tinsel over the thorax and out over the eye. Tie off the turkey with 2 loose wraps and secure with 3 or 4 tight wraps.

Trim the turkey and finish the head. Add a drop of head cement to the head and the top of the wing case.
